

HOW TO...

Make Template for Contour Pews



To begin, you will need a writing utensil, tape, a utility knife, a small piece of wood, and two pieces of cardboard large enough to fit the depth of your pew seat. Tape the writing utensil to the piece of wood.① The wood acts as a spacer as you draw the contour line of the seat. You will draw this line on the two pieces of cardboard (one for us, and one as a copy for you).

Next, place the piece of cardboard on the pew seat.②



Now take your utensil and rest the wood against the seat and slide from back to front to draw the contour line on the cardboard.③

Once the line has been drawn,④ use the utility knife to cut the contour. Set the cardboard on the seat to make sure the line you just cut fits snug against the contour of the pew. Last, label the contour with front and back.⑤
