

Side View A


Place a piece of heavy stock paperboard at the far edge of the pew, next to the armrest, perpendicular to the seat and against the back where it intersects the seat.

(See Side View A)

Using a compass, scribe the contour of the seat onto the paperboard and cut out the template at the line that you scribed. (See Side View B).

Place the trimmed template on the pew seat and review the contour for accuracy. The template should lay absolutely flush with the seat.

Place the finished template on the remaining pew seats. Record how many pew seats match this contour. If there are pews with a different contour, cut a separate template and mark each accordingly: A, B, C, etcetera.
